THE MUTUAL ASSISTANCE IN CRIMINAL MATTERS (DESIGNATION OF A CENTRAL AUTHORITY) ORDER, 2017, made by the Minister in exercise of his powers contained in section 4 of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act, 1993 No. 2 of 1993.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters (Designation of a Central Authority) Order, 2017.

2. Designation of a Central Authority

For the purposes of the Mutual Assistance in Criminal Matters Act 1993, Senator Maureen Hyman Payne, Parliamentary Secretary in the Ministry of Legal Affairs is, by this Order, designated the Central Authority for Antigua and Barbuda in any matter involving Cosbert Sergeant, Arleigh Byer and Jamal Kane.

3. Commencement

This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 31st of December, 2017.
