# THE MAGISTRATE'S COURT DISTRICT "B" ALL SAINTS ORDER, made pursuant to the Magistrate's Code of Procedure Act, Cap 255 Section 11.

#### 1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Magistrate's Court District "B" All Saints Order, 2008.
