THE MAGISTRATE'S COURT DISTRICT "C" BARBUDA ORDER, made by the Minister pursuant to the powers conferred upon him under section 11 subsection (2) of the Magistrate's Code of Procedure Act, Cap. 255 as amended.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Magistrate's Court District "C" Barbuda Order, 2014.

2. Sittings of Magistrate's Court (District "C") outside the District.

- (1) The Minister has appointed the Magistrate's Court District "A", St. John's, in the island of Antigua, as the place where the Magistrate's Court District "C" (Barbuda) shall where the circumstances require, sit and try persons charged with offences committed in the island of Barbuda.
- (2) The sittings of the Magistrate's Court District "C" Barbuda shall be held at the Magistrate's Court District "A", St. John's at 9.00 o'clock in the forenoon or such other time as the Magistrate presiding over the said court may appoint on any day of the week except Sunday.

3. Commencement

This Order comes into force on the 13th December, 2014.
