THE MAGISTRATE'S COURT ORDER, MADE BY THE MINISTER IN EXERCISE OF THE POWERS CONFERRED UPON HIM UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE MAGISTRATE'S CODE OF PROCEDURE ACT CAP. 255

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Magistrate's Court Order, 2013.

2. Appointment of the Court

The precincts of Her Majesty's Prisons on Coronation Road, in the Parish of St. John's is hereby appointed a Magistrate's Court to hear applications for purposes of remand for all Districts in Antigua and Barbuda.

3. Sittings of the Court

The Magistrate's Court shall sit at the precincts of Her Majesty's Prisons, Coronation Road, St. John's at 9:00 a.m. in the forenoon or such other time as the Magistrate presiding over the Court shall appoint on any day of the week except Sunday.

4. Commencement

This Order comes into force on the 1st day of February, 2013.
