**The Millennium Naturalisation (Amendment) Regulations, 2004 made under section 12 of the Millennium Naturalisation Act, 2004, No. 4 of 2004.**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Millennium Naturalisation (Amendment) Regulations, 2004. Short title.
