**NOTIFICATION BY THE GOVERNOR- GENERAL UNDER SECTION 10 OF THE LAND  
ACQUISITION ACT, CAP. 233 DECLARING THAT THE INTENDED ACQUISITION OF THE  
PARCELS OF LAND DESCRIBED BELOW IS ABANDONED**

**WHEREAS** by Section 10 of the Land Acquisition Act, Cap. 233, the Governor-General may, at any time before any land has been acquired compulsorily declare by Notification published in the Gazette that the intended acquisition of such land is abandoned.

**AND WHEREAS** the only publication published in The *Gazette* of the Declaration of the Cabinet for the Acquisition of the below mentioned parcels of land was the first publication which appeared in **Volume XXIX of Gazette No. 27 of 9<sup>th</sup> April 2009.**

**AND WHEREAS** by a Consent Order dated 21<sup>st</sup> May 2010 in High Court Claim No. ANUHCV 2009/0113 Between Stanford International Bank Limited and others as Applicants v. Attorney General of Antigua and Barbuda as Respondent it was ordered “(3) That the Respondent shall forthwith cause a notification to be published in the Gazette declaring that the intended acquisition of the following parcels of land is abandoned pursuant to Section 10 of the Land Acquisition Act, Cap. 233.”

**NOW THEREFORE, I LOUISE AGNETHA LAKE-TACK, DAME GRAND CROSS OF THE MOST DISTINGUISHED ORDER OF ST.MICHAEL AND ST.GEORGE, GOVERNOR-GENERAL OF ANTIGUA AND BARBUDA,** hereby declare that the intended acquisition of the parcels of land described below is abandoned.
