Notice by the Minister under section 22 of the Fisheries Act Cap. 173

1. This Notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Marine Reserve Area) Notice, 2005.

Short title.

2. The areas of the waters of Antigua and Barbuda and the surrounding lands demarcated in the Schedule and described as the North East Marine Management Area, are hereby declared to be marine reserves.

- 2. the landward edges of the mangrove and wetland systems from Beggars Point in the Parish of St. Peter to Friars Head, in the Parish of St. Phillip, where the mangrove exist and the line of permanent vegetation at the coastline where no mangrove exist, and


