THE NATIONAL PARKS (DEVIL'S BRIDGE) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in Section 20 of the National Parks Act, Cap. 290.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the National Parks (Fort Barrington) Order, 2008.

2. Declaration of National Park

The area described in the Schedule is declared to be a National Park.

SCHEDULE

DEVIL'S BRIDGE NATIONAL PARK

Description of Devil's Bridge National Park

The Devil's Bridge National Park consists of all that area measuring approximately two hundred and forty-five acres and more particularly described as follows—

From point 1889745N, 433120E, eastwards 501.792m to point 1889690N, 433618.810E out at sea eastwards 957.128m to point 1889648N, 434575E, thence north 1185.459m to 1890833N, 434608E, thence west southwest mid-channel 1422.737m to point 1890075N, 433404E, thence west northwest 42.720m to point 1890087N, 433363E, thence west 71.344m to point 1890080N, 433292E, thence west southwest 30.806m to point 1890050N, 433285E then returning south 346.711m to first point 1889745N, 433120E.
