THE NATIONAL PARKS (FORT BARRINGTON) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in Section 20 of the National Parks Act, Cap. 290.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the National Parks (Fort Barrington) Order, 2008.

2. Declaration of National Park

The area described in the Schedule is declared to be a National Park.

SCHEDULE

FORT BARRINGTON NATIONAL PARK

Description of Fort Barrington National Park

The Fort Barrington National Park consists of all that area measuring approximately 34.5 hectares and more particularly described as follows—

From point E 411700, N 1893750, South 450 metres to E 411700, N 1893300, thence east 300 metres to point E 4120000, N 1893300, thence North 100 metres to point E 4120000, N 1893400, thence east 600 metres to point E 412600, N 1893400, thence North 350 metres to point E 412600, N 1894050, thence returning to the starting point 900 metres West to E 411700, N 1893750.
