THE POLICE ACT (PRESCRIBED FEE FOR ACCIDENT REPORTS) ORDER made in exercise of the powers contained in section 23(2) of the Police Act Cap 330.

1. Short title

This Order may be cited as the Police Act (Prescribed Fee for Accident Reports) Order, 2017.

2. Prescribed Fee

There shall be paid by every person to the Commissioner of Police for the Treasury, a fee of \$EC 200.00 for each police report applied for in respect of a Traffic Accident.
