THE PESTICIDES AND TOXIC CHEMICALS ACT (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 1) REGULATIONS, 2022 made in exercise of the powers contained in section 3 (3) of the Pesticides and Toxic Chemicals Act, 2008, No 12 of 2008.

1. Short title

These Regulations may be cited as the Pesticides and Toxic Chemicals Act (Amendment of Schedule 1) Regulations, 2022.

2. Interpretation

"principal Act" means the Pesticides and Toxic Chemicals Act, 2008.

3. Amendment of Schedule 1

The principal Act is amended in Schedule 1 by deleting clause 1 in its entirety and substituting the following—

- "1 The Board shall consist of such number of members, but not exceeding nine (9), appointed by the Minister, representing relevant interest groups in Antigua and Barbuda including but not limited to the following—
 - (a) Chief Scientist or their designate;
 - (b) Chief Health Inspector or their designate;
 - (c) Head of the National Plant Protection Organisation or their designate
 - (d) Comptroller of Customs or their designate
 - (e) President of Pharmacy Council or their designate
 - (j) Agricultural services;
 - (g) Legal Officer from the Ministry of Legal Affairs; and
 - (h) Environmental services.".
