Proclamation dated the 10th day of July, 1996 declaring a Close Season for Cotton.

A PROCLAMATION

Sir James Beethoven Carlisle,
Governor-General.

WHEREAS by section 3 of the Cotton Protection Act (Cap. 111) it is provided that the Governor-General on the advice of the Cabinet may by proclamation published in the *Gazette*, declare any period of each year to be a close season within the meaning of the Cotton Protection Act, either for the whole of Antigua and Barbuda or for such area or areas thereof as may be specified in such proclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, on the advice of the Cabinet, do by this my PROCLAMATION declare that the period 15th May, to 15th August, 1996, both days inclusive shall be a Close Season within the meaning of the Cotton Protection Act for the whole of Antigua and Barbuda.

AND all Her Majesty's loving subjects in Antigua and Barbuda and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.
