Proclamation dated the 11th day of March, 1997, Proroguing Parliament.

A PROCLAMATION

Joseph Myers,
Governor-General's Deputy.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60 (1) of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may, at any time prorogue Parliament.

NOW THEREFORE, I JOSEPH MYERS, the Governor-General's Deputy, acting on behalf of the Governor-General, SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on the 12th day of March, 1997.

AND the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua, this 11th day of March, 1997, and in the forty-sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
