BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the city of St. John's as the place at which the First Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00 a.m. on the 17th day of February, 2023 as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua this 17th day of February, 2023 and in the first year of His Majesty's Reign
