**Proclamation dated the 1st day of March, 1995, Appointing the Place and Time
for the Second Session of Parliament.**

A PROCLAMATION

James Carlisle,

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59 (1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW THEREFORE, I JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Parliament Drive in the City of St. John as the place at which the Second Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00 a.m. on the 16th day of March, 1995 as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua, this 1st day of March, 1995
and in the forty-fourth year of Her Majesty's
Reign.
