**PROCLAMATION** dated the 29th day of November 2006, appointing the 11th day of December, 2006 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act Cap. 345 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation declaring that it is inexpedient in any year that a day by this Act appointed a public holiday shall not in such year be a public holiday, and appoint such other day as to him may seem fit to be a public holiday instead of such day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet—

- (a) declare that for the year 2006, Saturday the 9th of December, 2006 shall not be a public holiday in Antigua and Barbuda in commemoration of National Heroes Day; and
- (b) instead do appoint Monday the 11th of December, 2006 to be the public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda commemorating National Heroes Day.
