## A PROCLAMATION

Joseph Myers, Governor-General's Deputy.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59 (1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW THEREFORE, I JOSEPH MYERS, the Governor-General's Deputy, acting on behalf of the Governor-General, SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Parliament Drive in the City of St. John's as the place at which the Fourth Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00 a.m. on the 21st day of March, 1997 as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua, this 11th day of March, 1997, and in the forty-sixth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
