**A PROCLAMATION**

**WHEREAS** it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I DAME LOUISE LAKE-TACK,** Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do appoint Tuesday 19th February, 2008 to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda on the occasion of the State Funeral of the late The Honourable Charlesworth T. Samuel, Member of Parliament for the Constituency of All Saints East and St. Luke and Minister of Agriculture, Lands, Marine Resources and Agro Industry.

**GIVEN** at the Governor-General's Office, St. John's, Antigua, this 13th day of February, 2008, in the fifty-seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign.
