**WHEREAS** it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I DAME LOUISE LAKE-TACK,** Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do appoint Tuesday 18th March, 2008 to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda on the occasion of the State Funeral of the late The Honourable Sir George Herbert Walter, Former Premier of Antigua and Barbuda.
