Proclamation dated the 15th day of November, 2005, Proroguing Parliament.

APROCLAMATION

James B. Carlisle, Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60(1) of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minster may, at any time, prorogue Parliament.

NOW, THEREFORE, I JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on Wednesday the 16th November, 2005.

AND THE PRESIDENT of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the member of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.

Given at the Governor-General's Residence, St. Johns, Antigua this 15th day of November, 2005 and in the fifty-fourth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
