Proclamation dated the 15th day of September, 2000, appointing the 8th day of August, 2000 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR JAMES B. CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do appoint Tuesday 8th day of August, 2000, to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office, St. John's, Antigua, this 15th day of September, 2000, in the forty-eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
