PROCLAMATION dated the 17th day of December, 2020, appointing the 28th of December, 2020 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

A PROCLAMATION

Sir Rodney Williams,
Governor General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 (*b*) of the Public Act Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation declaring that it is inexpedient in any year that a day by this Act appointed a public holiday shall not in such year be a public holiday, and appoint such other as to him may seem fit to be a public holiday instead of such day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet –

- (*a*) declare that it is inexpedient that Saturday the 26th of December, 2020, the day appointed a public holiday under the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 354 in commemoration of Boxing Day should be a public holiday; and
- (*b*) instead do appoint Monday the 28th of December, 2020 to be the public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda commemorating Boxing Day.
