Proclamation dated the 17th day of February, 1993, Appointing the Place and Time for the Fifth Session of Parliament.

A PROCLAMATION

Wilfred Jacobs, Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59 (1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW THEREFORE, I Wilfred Jacobs, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Knight Grand Cross of the Royal Victorian Order, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, One of Her Majesty's Counsel, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Parliament Drive in the City of St. John as the place at which the Fifth Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00 a.m. on the 25th day of February, 1993, as the time at which that session shall begin.

Given at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua this 17th day of February, 1993, and in the forty-second year of Her Majesty's Reign.
