Proclamation dated the 17th day of February, 1993, Proroguing Parliament.

A PROCLAMATION

Wilfred Jacobs, Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60 (1) of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may, at any time prorogue Parliament.

NOW, THEREFORE, I Wilfred Jacobs, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Knight Grand Cross of the Royal Victorian Order, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, One of Her Majesty's Counsel, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on the 20th day of February, 1993.

AND the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.

Given at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua this 17th day of February, 1993 and in the forty-second year of Her Majesty's Reign.
