Proclamation dated the 17th day of February, 1999, Dissolving Parliament.

BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

A PROCLAMATION

James B. Carlisle, Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is provided by subsection (1) of section 60 of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, may at anytime dissolve Parliament.

NOW THEREFORE, I, JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting in accordance with the advice of the Honourable Prime Minister, do hereby dissolve Parliament on Friday the nineteenth day of February, 1999.

AND the President of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, Members of the Senate and the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are required to take due notice hereof.

Given under my hand at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua this 17th day of February, 1999, and in the forty-eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign.
