Proclamation dated the 17th day of March, 1994, Appointing the Place and Time for the First Session of Parliament.

A PROCLAMATION

James B. Carlisle,
Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is proclaimed by section 59 (1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I James Beethoven Carlisle, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Parliament Drive in the City of St. John's as the place at which the First Session of Parliament shall be held, and 9:00 a.m. on the 21st day of March, 1994, as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua this 17th day of March, 1994, and in the forty-third year of Her Majesty's Reign.
