Proclamation dated the 17th day of March, 1995 appointing part of Wednesday 22nd March, 1995 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

WHEREAS it is provided by Section 5 of the Public Holidays Act (Cap. 201) that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

NOW, THEREFORE, I JAMES B. CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do hereby appoint that part of Wednesday 22nd March, 1995 commencing from twelve o'clock noon to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.
