Proclamation dated the 17th day of March, 1998, Appointing the Place and Time for the Fifth Session of Parliament.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59 (1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Parliament Drive in the City of St. John's as the place at which the Fifth Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00 a.m. on the 19th day of March, 1998 as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua, this 18th day of March, 1998, and in the forty-seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign.
