WHEREAS it is provided by Section 5 of the Public Holidays Act (Cap. 354) that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of Cabinet, do hereby appoint Tuesday the 6th day of August, 1996 to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.
