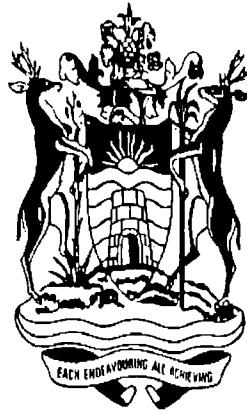



A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59 (1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I DAME LOUISE AGNETHA LAKE-TACK, GCMG, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the city of St. John's as the place at which the Second Session of Parliament shall be held at 9:00 a.m. on the 23rd of November, 2009 as the time at which that session shall begin.

November, 2009 and in the fifty-
eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign
