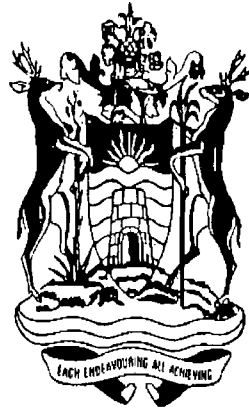



A PROCLAMATION



Louise A. Lake-Tack,

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60 (1) of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may, at any time, prorogue Parliament.

NOW, THEREFORE, I DAME LOUISE AGNETHA LAKE-TACK, GCMG, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on Friday the 20th of November, 2009.

AND THE PRESIDENT of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are required to take due notice hereof.

eighth year of Her Majesty's Reign
