WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

NOW, THEREFORE, I JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do hereby appoint part of Friday the 20th day of March, 1998, commencing from twelve o'clock noon to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.
