A PROCLAMATION

Sir Rodney Williams,
Governor General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60(1) of the Constitution that the Governor General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may, at any time, prorogue Parliament.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, Governor General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on the 19th day of December, 2018.

AND THE PRESIDENT of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.
