A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 18(1) of the Representation of the People Act, Cap. 379, as amended, that the Governor-General shall by Proclamation specify a period within which a person who is qualified under Section 16 may apply in accordance with the Registration Regulations, to be registered as an elector in the constituency in which he qualifies to be so registered.

WHEREAS at the end of the period referred to in subsection (1) the Commission shall cause to be prepared a register of the electors for each constituency and thereafter the Commission shall publish the register for each constituency as follows:—

In respect of the said period immediately subsequent to the commencement of this section the Commission shall publish the register not later than such date as the Governor-General after consultation with the commission shall by Proclamation specify.

WHEREAS the Governor-General after consultation with the Antigua and Barbuda Electoral Commission considers it expedient that a proclamation be issued in accordance with Section 18(1)(a) of the Representation of the People (Amendment) Act.
