Proclamation dated the 20th day of November, 2006, Appointing the Place and Time for the Fourth Session of Parliament.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the city of St. John's as the place at which the Fourth Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00 a.m. on Thursday the 23rd of November, 2006 as the time at which that session shall begin.

November, 2006 and in the fifty-fifth
year of Her Majesty's Reign.
