**BY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL
A PROCLAMATION**

Sir Rodney Williams,
Governor General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5(b) of the Public Holidays Act Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation declaring that it is inexpedient in any year that a day by this Act appointed a public holiday shall not in such year be a public holiday, and appoint such other day as to him may seem fit to be a public holiday instead of such day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Sir Rodney Williams, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet –

- (a) declare that it is inexpedient that Saturday the 9th of December, 2017, the day appointed a public holiday under the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 354 in commemoration of the Sir V.C. Bird Day should be a public holiday; and
- (b) instead do appoint Monday the 11th of December, 2017 to be the public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda commemorating Sir V.C. Bird Day.
