Proclamation dated the 22nd day of December, 1993 declaring a Close Planting Season for Cotton.

A PROCLAMATION

James B. Carlisle, Governor-General.

WHEREAS by section 3 of the Cotton Planting (Regulation) Act (Cap. 94) it is provided that the Governor-General on the advice of the Cabinet may by proclamation published in the *Gazette* and by public notice, declare any period of each year to be a close planting season within the meaning of the said Act, either for the whole of Antigua and Barbuda or for such area or areas thereof as may be specified in such proclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, on the advice of the Cabinet, do by this my Proclamation declare that the period 16th October, 1993 to 31st July, 1994, both days inclusive, shall be a close planting season within the meaning of the said Act for the whole of Antigua and Barbuda.

AND all Her Majesty's loving subjects in Antigua and Barbuda and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.
