WHEREAS it is provided by Section 5 of the Public Holidays Act (Cap. 201) that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

NOW THEREFORE, I JAMES B. CARLISLE, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda with the advice of Cabinet, do hereby appoint Tuesday the 3rd day of August, 1993 to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.
