Proclamation dated the 23rd day of July, 1997, appointing Tuesday the 5th day of August, 1997 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

NOW, THEREFORE, I JOSEPH MYERS, the Governor-General's Deputy, acting on behalf of SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do hereby appoint Tuesday the 5th day of August, 1997 to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.
