

**A PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I DAME LOUISE AGNETHA LAKE-TACK, GCMG, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the city of St. John's as the place at which the First Session of Parliament shall be held at 9:00 a.m. on the 25th day of June, 2014 as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's,  
Antigua this 23rd day of June, 2014 and in the sixty-  
third year of Her Majesty's Reign.
