A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60 (1) of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may, at any time, prorogue Parliament.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR EUSTACE B. FRANCIS, KCN, Governor-General's Deputy, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on Thursday the 24th of November, 2011.

AND THE PRESIDENT of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the Members of the Senate and of the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof.

this 23rd day of November, 2011 and in the sixtieth
year of Her Majesty's Reign
