WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act (Cap. 354) that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General, with the advice of the Cabinet, to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do appoint Saturday the 1st January, 2005 and Monday 3rd January, 2005 as public holidays throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office, St. John's, Antigua this 24th day of December, 2004 and in the fifty-third year of Her Majesty's Reign.
