WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do appoint Wednesday 24th day of March, 2004 to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office, St. John's, Antigua this 24th day of March, 2004 and in the fifty-second year of Her Majesty's Reign.
