Proclamation dated the 25th day of July, 1995 declaring a Close Planting Season for Cotton.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by section 3 of the Cotton Planting (Regulations) Act (Cap. 94) it is provided that the Governor-General on the advice of the Cabinet may by proclamation published in the *Gazette* and by public notice, declare any period of each year to be a close planting season within the meaning of the said Act, either for the whole of Antigua and Barbuda or for such areas thereof as may be specified in such proclamation.

NOW, THEREFORE, I DR. REGINALD A. WALWYN, Governor-General's Deputy of Antigua and Barbuda, on the advice of the Cabinet, do by this my PROCLAMATION declare that the period 1st June, 1995 to 15th August, 1995, both days inclusive, be declared the Cotton Close Season within the meaning of the said Act for the whole of Antigua and Barbuda.

AND all Her Majesty's loving subjects in Antigua and Barbuda and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice hereof and to give their ready obedience accordingly.
