**Proclamation dated the 25th day of March, 2004, Appointing the Place and Time
for the First Session of Parliament.**

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW, THEREFORE, I SIR JAMES BEETHOVEN CARLISLE, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Parliament Drive in the city of St. John's as the place at which the First Session of Parliament shall be held and 2:00 p.m. on the 29th day of March, 2004 as the time at which that session shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office, St. John's, Antigua this 25th day of March, 2004 and in the fifty-second year of Her Majesty's Reign.
