WHEREAS by a Proclamation dated the 23rd day of September 1998, the Cabinet declared a state of Emergency under the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act, Cap. 148;

AND WHEREAS by Section 2 (3) of the Emergency Powers (Hurricane, Earthquake, Fire or Flood) Act Cap. 148 a proclamation so made shall be communicated to the Legislature and the Legislature shall accordingly meet and sit upon the day appointed by proclamation, and shall continue to sit and act in like manner as if it had stood adjourned or prorogued to the same day;

NOW THEREFORE, I James Beethoven Carlisle, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building as the Place at which Parliament shall be held and 10:00 a.m. on Monday the 28th day of September, 1998 as the time at which that meeting shall begin.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Residence, St. John's, Antigua this 25th day of September, 1998 and in the forty-seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign.
