**PROCLAMATION** dated the 26th day of August, 2008, appointing part of Monday, 1st September, 2008, starting from midday, to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

**WHEREAS** it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act, Cap. 354 that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General with the advice of the Cabinet to issue a Proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I DAME LOUISE LAKE-TACK,** Dame Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of St. Michael and St. George, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of the Cabinet, do appoint the second half of Monday, 1st September, 2008, starting from midday, to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda in observance of the National Day of Fasting and Prayer, organized by the representatives of the Christian Community in Antigua and Barbuda.

**GIVEN** at the Governor-General's Office, St. John's, Antigua, this 26th day of August, 2008, in the fifty-seventh year of Her Majesty's Reign.
