Proclamation dated the 28th day of July, 1994 appointing Tuesday the 2nd day of August, 1994 as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 5 of the Public Holidays Act (Cap. 201) that it shall be lawful for the Governor-General to issue a proclamation appointing a special day or part of a day to be reserved as a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.

NOW THEREFORE, I ALGERNON BOYD, Order of the British Empire, Order of Honour, Governor-General's Deputy of Antigua and Barbuda, with the advice of Cabinet, do hereby appoint Tuesday the 2nd day of August, 1994 to be a public holiday throughout Antigua and Barbuda.
