PROCLAMATION dated the 30th day of December, 2014, Proroguing Parliament.

BY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL

A PROCLAMATION

Sir Rodney Williams, Governor-General.

WHEREAS it is provided by section 60(1) of the Constitution that the Governor-General, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister may, at any time, prorogue Parliament.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, Governor-General of Antigua and Barbuda, acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, do hereby prorogue Parliament on Wednesday the 31st December, 2014.

AND THE PRESIDENT of the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the members of the Senate and the House of Representatives, and all others whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice.

GIVEN at the Governor-General's Office, Antigua, this 31st day of December, 2014, and in the sixty-third year of Her Majesty's Reign.
