A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided by section 59(1) of the Constitution that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Antigua and Barbuda and shall begin at such time as the Governor General shall by Proclamation appoint.

NOW THEREFORE, I SIR RODNEY WILLIAMS, GCMG, Governor General of Antigua and Barbuda, do hereby appoint the Parliament Building at Queen Elizabeth Highway in the City of St. John's as the place at which the Fifth Session of Parliament shall be held and 9:00a.m. on the **20th day of January, 2022** as the Time at which that session shall begin.
